Important Questions	Answers	Why This Matters:
<b>What is the overall deductible?</b>	For each Plan Year, In-Network: Individual \$2,500 / Family \$5,000.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan, each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible.
<b>Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?</b>	Yes. Emergency care; plus in-network office visits, prescription drugs & preventive care are covered before you meet your deductible.	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost sharing and before you meet your deductible. <b>Are there other deductibles for specific services?</b>	No.	You don't have to meet deductibles for specific services.
<b>What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan?</b>	In-Network: Individual \$5,000 / Family \$10,000.	The out-of-pocket limit is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this plan, they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limits until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met.
<b>What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit?</b>	Premiums, balance-billing charges & health care this plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out-of-pocket limit.
<b>Will you pay less if you use a network provider?</b>	Yes. See <a href="http://www.aetna.com/docfind">www.aetna.com/docfind</a> or call 1-800-370-4526 for a list of in-network providers.	This plan uses a provider network. You will pay less if you use a provider in the plan's network. You will pay the most if you use an out-of-network provider, and you might receive a bill from a provider for the difference between the provider's charge and what your plan pays (balance billing). Be aware, your network provider might use an out-of-network provider for some services (such as lab work). Check with your provider before you get services.
<b>Do you need a referral to see a specialist?</b>	No.	You can see the specialist you choose without a referral.

- Non-emergency care when traveling outside the U.S.
- Private-duty nursing

#### Other Covered Services (Limitations may apply to these services. This isn't a complete list. Please see your plan document.)

- Acupuncture - 10 visits/plan year for disease, injury & chronic pain.
- Chiropractic care - 20 visits/plan year.
- Hearing aids - \$2,500 maximum/2 years.
- Infertility treatment - Limited to the diagnosis & treatment of underlying medical condition.
- Routine eye care (Adult) - 1 routine eye exam/24 months.

**Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes.**

Minimum Essential Coverage generally includes plans, health insurance available through the Marketplace or other individual market policies, Medicare, Medicaid, CHIP, TRICARE, and certain other coverage. If you are eligible for certain types of Minimum Essential Coverage, you may not be eligible for the premium tax credit.

**Does this plan meet Minimum Value Standards? Yes.**

If your plan doesn't meet the Minimum Value Standards, you may be eligible for a premium tax credit to help you pay for a plan through the Marketplace.

**This is not a cost estimator.** Treatments shown are just examples of how this plan might cover medical care. Your actual costs will be different depending on the actual care you receive, the prices your providers charge, and many other factors. Focus on the cost-sharing amounts (deductibles, copayments and coinsurance) and excluded services under the plan. Use this information to compare the portion of costs you might pay under different health plans. Please note these coverage examples are based on self-only coverage.

**Peg is Having a Baby**  
(9 months of in-network pre-natal care and a hospital delivery)
